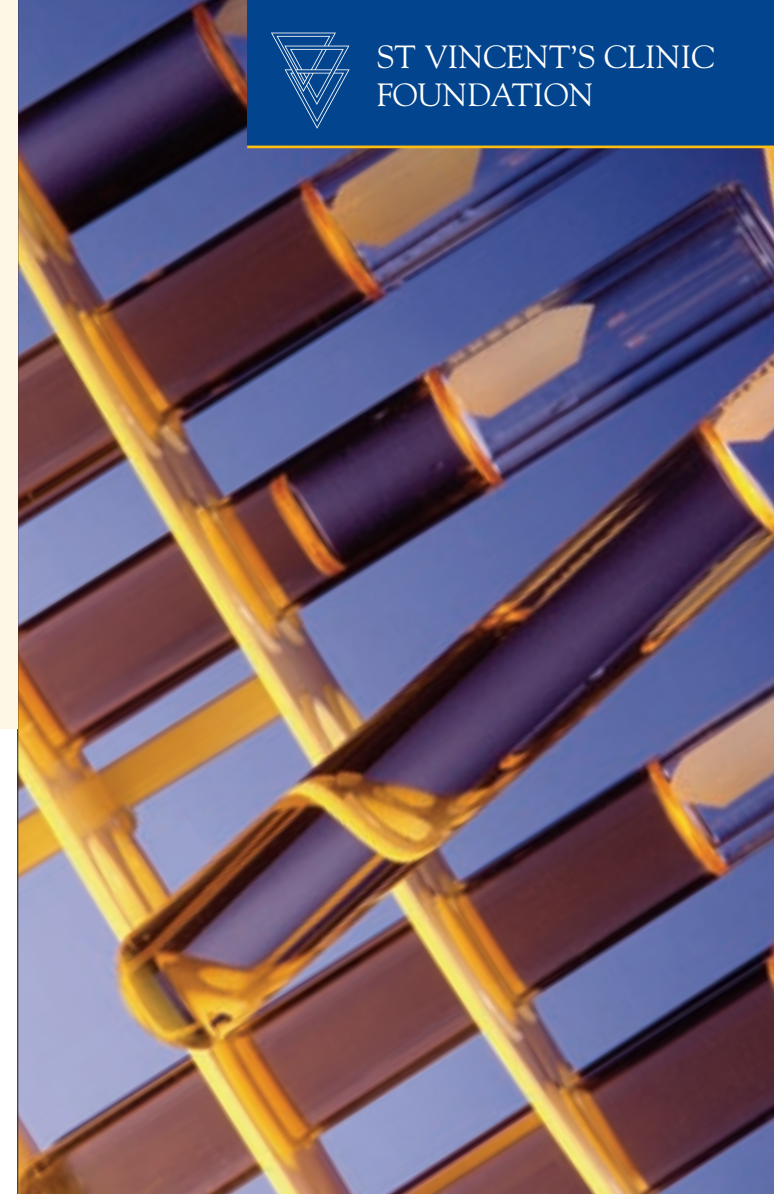

Established in 1992, the St Vincent's Clinic Foundation has strengthened the research and educational aims of the Clinic. The Foundation provides funds and support for medical research into matters of clinical significance as well as providing support for public and medical education.

The Foundation continues to actively support ADULT stem cell research on the Campus. Research in this area is cutting edge and has the potential to provide the basis for major scientific breakthroughs and the development of new treatments.

Since 1992, the Foundation has provided over \$4 million in financial support for over 130 research projects. The Foundation has successfully supported vital research into disease and illness including:
