Anaesthesia

The Anaesthetic Department provides a comprehensive service to St Vincent's Private Hospital and the Day Surgery Unit located in the St Vincent's Clinic.

The St Vincent's Private Hospital Department of Anaesthesia is the oldest private hospital Department of Anaesthesia in Australia. It is based in Suite 808, where secretarial services coordinate all anaesthesia requirements across the private hospital and the clinic, and department members can access consulting rooms if they wish. Currently there are more than 50 anaesthetists accredited to the clinic and hospital.

The Department provides comprehensive anaesthesia services by specialist anaesthetists, all of whom possess a Fellowship from the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists. Many have spent additional years of training overseas. The Department's anaesthetists provide expert anaesthesia for every type of surgery and procedure undertaken at St Vincent's Clinic and St Vincent's Private Hospital. Members of the Department also run an Acute Pain referral service, available to any hospital inpatient, and managed by qualified Pain Medicine Specialists.

The Department provides for the surgeons and the hospital round the clock anaesthesia services whenever an anaesthetist is needed in hours and after hours. The Department has a long history of excellence in anaesthesia and provides regular continuing education and quality assurance sessions for its members. Many members have been, and are still, office bearers of the Australian Society of Anaesthetists and the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists. Several members have been examiners for the College of Anaesthetists. Many current members also provide anaesthesia services to St Vincent's Public Hospital as well as to other major hospitals throughout Sydney. The members of the Anaesthesia Department also work tirelessly in a voluntary capacity on a large number of committees at St Vincent's Private Hospital and St Vincent's Clinic, as well as various voluntary surgical teams throughout Asia-Pacific, Africa and South America.

Clinical Haematology

The Department of Haematology and Blood Stem Cell Transplantation provides a comprehensive service in diagnostic, therapeutic and consultative haematology.

The Areas of Expertise include:

- Blood and Bone Marrow Transplantation (allogeneic & autologous): Our service is accredited to carry out transplants which we report to the Australasian Bone Marrow Donor Registry as well as internationally to the CIBMTR and the EBMT. We have expertise in performing complex allogeneic stem cell transplants, including related, unrelated and haploidentical donor transplants. We host the Australasian Bone Marrow Transplant Recipient Registry (ABMTRR) which collects data on all the Blood Stem Cell Transplants carried out in Australia and New Zealand. We run regular long-term survivorship clinics for our transplant patients, working collaboratively with you to manage the long-term sequelae of transplantation and preventative health strategies. We also perform autologous stem cell transplants for a variety of blood and autoimmune diseases, especially severe Scleroderma and Multiple Sclerosis. We are the NSW Health approved centre for transplantation for Scleroderma.
- Clinical Trials: We have an active clinical trials unit which conducts fundamental research into blood diseases, blood-related cancers and bone marrow transplants. It gives our patients the opportunity to participate in some of the latest therapeutic advances.
- Research: We conduct fundamental clinical and laboratory research into a variety of blood diseases including the fields of blood cancer, bone marrow transplant and thrombosis / haemostasis, and autoimmune disease. Recent highlights include the

study of stem cell transplantation to treat severe autoimmune disease, the molecular markers of leukaemic cells and the role of genetic and coagulation testing for thromboembolism.

- HIV/AIDS-related cancers: We are the leading clinical centre in Australia for the treatment of haematologic malignancies associated with HIV infection and are a member of the AIDS Malignancy Consortium, collaborating with the Australian Kirby Institute, which conducts clinical trial research in this area.
- Apheresis service
- Thrombosis / Haemostasis including platelet disorders

Colorectal Surgery

In addition to the spectrum of general surgical procedures, this Department offers a specialised service in all aspects of surgery of the colon, rectum and anus.

This service includes:

- Day-only endoscopy and colonoscopy service
- Complete investigative services for rectal bleeding immediately available, together with the management of bowel polyps, including programmes for ongoing surveillance
- Laparoscopic colectomy for benign and malignant condition when indicated
- Special expertise in sphincter-saving procedures for cancer of the rectum including colo-anal anastomoses and abdomino-perineal pull-through procedures
- Total management of colon and rectal malignancy (only one in 20 patients now requires a permanent colostomy)
- Specialised treatment of diverticular disease and its complications, including bladder and vaginal fistulas, and also of ulcerative colitis and Crohn's disease, where total proctocolectomy and ileo-anal pouch procedures have dramatically improved the patient's quality of life

- Specialised service for complicated fistula in ano, cure of rectal prolapse, management of ano-rectal incontinence and management of rectal trauma
- A state-of-the-art Anal Physiology Laboratory including endorectal ultrasound to fully assess all aspects of faecal incontinence and sphincter impairments

The unit treats all aspects of anal disease, including haemorrhoids, fissure, hydradenitis, anal cancer and pilonidal sinus. Many of the minor anal problems are treated on a day-only basis utilising the Day Surgery Unit at St Vincent's Clinic.

The Head and Neck Service delivers world-class cancer care to all patients. All Head and Neck Surgeons at St Vincent's are Otolaryngology (ENT) trained, ensuring expertise in airway and anterior skullbase disease.

Head and Neck Cancer

The Head and Neck Service at St Vincent's has a national and international reputation for excellence. More than 350 cancer patients are seen annually at the Head & Neck Cancer

Multidisciplinary Team Meeting at The Kinghorn Cancer Centre, a combined facility of St Vincent's Hospital and The Garvan Institute. Health Assessment Centre

The Health Assessment Centre, owned and operated by Executive Health Solutions (EHS), is located on Level 4 of the Clinic. The centre provides a number of health assessment and health management programs.

The centre offers programs to both the corporate sector (delivered by EHS) and to the general public (delivered by Life First). All health assessments involve a head to toe analysis aimed at identifying health risks before they become problematic. Patients spend significant time with Exercise Physiologists and Doctors discussing their results and recommendations about how best to improve their health status.

Each of the EHS or Life First health programmes are designed to identify any health risks through a comprehensive medical and lifestyle appraisal.

Our experienced medical teams are experts in delivering the preventative and diagnostic examinations that detect early signs of disease and emphasise healthy lifestyles, risk factor management and personal behaviour change. Once health risks are identified, our targeted intervention programmes assist individuals to make changes to their lifestyle that result in improved health, productivity and quality of life.

The assessment process takes anywhere between 2-4 hours depending on the depth of medical analysis and imaging. Approximately 70% of diseases can be modified or prevented by lifestyle changes, including 50% of heart disease, stroke and diabetes and one third of cancers.

During the assessment, a full medical examination is performed including family and medical history, exercise stress/ECG to assess cardiovascular fitness, full lifestyle review and counselling and extensive pathology including liver function, cholesterol and blood sugar. Any urgent medical issues are immediately referred to the appropriate specialist from a large network of physicians.

However, patients are recommended to see a regular General Practitioner.

Medical Oncology

The Medical Oncology team from the Kinghorn Cancer Centre provides inpatient and outpatient medical oncology services for patients of St Vincent's Clinic.

The Medical Oncologists work in close collaboration with surgical and radiation oncologists. The department also works with palliative care, genetics, theranostics and haematology.

The department has special expertise in enrolling patients into clinical trials for new and evolving cancer treatments, specifically for “phase 1” clinical trials for rare and refractory cancers. Recognised by the NSW Cancer Institute for the Best Cancer Clinical Trials unit in 2018-19, the co-ordinated “precision medicine” approach of the multi-disciplinary team aims to consistently get the best outcomes for patients.

Patients who are being investigated for, or who have been diagnosed with cancer are provided with holistic management of their disease. All treatment options are considered within the context of patient comorbidities and wishes, and clearly defined treatment aims. Excellence in communication with patients, their families, their General Practitioner and other health professionals is provided. Where appropriate, patients are discussed at Multidisciplinary Clinics to ensure access to best practice, including the possibility of being included in clinical trials. Cancer patients are seen in a timely manner, and will always be accommodated in a short timeframe, according to their needs. The privacy and efficiency of the practice at St Vincent's Clinic allow optimal management of patients with this confronting diagnosis.

Neurosurgery

The Department of Neurosurgery is one of the largest neurosurgical units in NSW. It treats over 3,000 patients per year, has dedicated neurosurgical wards in both Public and Private Hospitals, and has an operative caseload of more than 1,500 cases per year at St Vincent's Private Hospital.

The Department provides services for all aspects of Neurosurgical problems, including:

- Spinal Disorders for acute disc prolapse, sciatica and brachialgia, degenerative disorders of spinal canal stenosis; both benign and malignant spinal tumours. This involves open, minimally invasive and percutaneous procedures and instrumentation and artificial disc for complex spinal procedures.
- Cerebral tumours, both benign and malignant tumours, both primary glioma and metastases. Stereotactic localisation and navigation is an essential part of this surgery, biopsy and excision of tumours.
- Skull base tumours, in association with the Head & Neck and Otolaryngology Departments. Endoscopic approaches to pituitary tumours and anterior skull base tumour are undertaken, and removal of acoustic tumours.
- Neurovascular both open procedures and neurointerventional, for aneurysm, AVMs and stroke.

- Functional Stereotaxy for movement disorders, deep brain stimulation for Parkinson's Disease and dystonia.
- Hydrocephalus and CSF circulation disorders syringomyelia.

All the members of the Neurosurgery Department are Fellows of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons and members of the Neurosurgical Society of Australasia.

The Department has two positions for neurosurgical training towards FRACS.

The Neurosurgical Department is involved in the Research Strategic Plan with the aim of becoming a centre of excellence for neurosciences research.

Oesophageal Diagnostic Services

Oesophageal Diagnostic Services is an open-access service to all clinicians providing physiological studies for the investigation of:

- Heartburn
- Atypical chest pain
- Reflux related cough/dysphonia
- Dysphagia
- Regurgitation/vomiting
- Assessment for anti-reflux surgery

Indications for ambulatory pH monitoring:

- For the definitive diagnosis of gastro-oesophageal reflux in patients sufficiently symptomatic to have warranted endoscopy but in whom endoscopy is normal or equivocal
- To investigate the possibility of acid reflux as a cause of atypical symptoms such as angina-like chest pain, respiratory and laryngeal symptoms in whom the relevant investigations have been inconclusive and to correlate such symptoms with reflux episodes
- When established gastro-oesophageal reflux responds poorly to optimal medical therapy and particularly when surgical treatment is contemplated
- In the assessment of patients with complex oesophageal disorders

Indications for oesophageal manometry:

- To establish the diagnosis and categorise suspected oesophageal motility disorders such as achalasia and diffuse spasm in patients with dysphagia or chest pain in whom other investigations are negative or equivocal
- To ascertain the pressure of the lower sphincter zone and presence of hiatal herniation
- For the accurate placement of pH electrodes for 24 hour pH monitoring
- Before surgical treatment for reflux, particularly in those patients undergoing surgery or if there is diagnostic uncertainty
- In the assessment of patients with complex oesophageal disorders

Ophthalmology

The Eye Department of St Vincent's Clinic provides a complete range of ophthalmic medical and surgical procedures. There are sub-specialists covering every aspect of ophthalmic treatment and these ophthalmologists are recognised as leaders in their field.

In addition to specialised treatment, routine eye examinations and visual assessments are carried out. The members of the Department have access to the most modern ophthalmic surgical facilities in the Clinic's Day Surgery Unit as well as access to all forms of medical ophthalmic laser treatment.

The Day Surgery Unit is fully equipped for all aspects of corneal surgery, cataract surgery, glaucoma surgery and oculoplastic surgery. These procedures are usually carried out as day only, but when indicated patients can stay overnight in St Vincent's Private Hospital.

The department's consulting rooms have the latest diagnostic ophthalmic equipment, including visual field analysis, retinal photography and angiography, ophthalmic ultrasound and OCT (optical coherence tomography) for detailed optic nerve evaluation, especially for glaucoma and retinal evaluation for macular degeneration and diabetic retinopathy.

There are also three lasers in the department – Argon laser to treat retinal conditions, YAG laser for post-cataract surgery capsulotomy and SLT laser for glaucoma.

Clinical Psychology

Clinical psychologists provide a wide range of psychological services (including assessment, diagnosis and treatment) to individuals with psychological conditions that range from mild to severe and complex.

Dr Jeanette Stewart (Head of Department) is a member of the APS College of Clinical Neuropsychology and Clinical Psychology. She is the Head of the Psychology Department at the Clinic. Her clinical interests include assessment of cognitive functioning in neurological/neurosurgical patients, including those with head injury, dementia, stroke, infections, or other general medical conditions. In addition, she has an interest in the assessment of capacity (testamentary capacity, capacity for managing affairs, etc) and regularly provides medico-legal reports for civil and criminal matters. She specialises on working with adult patients over the age of 16.

Mr Peter Rawling is a member of the APS College of Clinical Neuropsychology and has a major interest in neuropsychological assessments in the context of traumatic brain injury or neurological illness (dementia, vascular disease, immunological disorders).

Dr Hepner is a full member of the APS College of Clinical Neuropsychologists with expertise in the

neuropsychological assessment of clients 16 years and older across a range of neurological, medical and psychiatric conditions (e.g., neurodegenerative disease / dementia, traumatic brain injury, stroke, epilepsy, brain tumour, ADHD, depression, schizophrenia, substance dependence). Her interests include decision-making capacity, acquired brain injury, neurodegenerative disease/dementia and cognitive rehabilitation. Our staff includes doctors, nurses, radiation therapists, and physicists. They are part of the multidisciplinary teams, dedicated to providing excellent patient care. Additionally, they are involved in ongoing research that allows access to a range of international and local clinical trials.

GenesisCare has developed close links with other specialists involved in the diagnosis and treatment of cancer via a range of multidisciplinary clinics. We have integrated participation in high quality multidisciplinary clinics for head and neck cancers, breast cancers, prostate cancers and other urological cancers, gastrointestinal cancer, skin and melanoma cancers and neurological cancers.

Our state of the art equipment is comprised of ten linear accelerators, 6 CT scanners, Australia's first Gamma Knife, and an Integrated Brachytherapy Theatre providing for both High Dose and Low Dose Rate Brachytherapy. The linear accelerator technology has image Guided Radiation Therapy (IGRT), which

allows for greater accuracy and precision of tumour delineation and treatment.

GenesisCare also has a comprehensive stereotactic service giving patients access to Australia's first and only Gamma Knife (GK) in Macquarie University Hospital, a form of stereotactic radiosurgery (SRS). Stereotactic radiosurgery is a highly precise, non-invasive treatment either in a single fraction or in multiple visits.

SRS, initially developed to treat small brain tumours and functional abnormalities of the brain, is also delivered safely and effectively using our linear accelerators across our NSW treatment centres.

Stereotactic body radiation therapy techniques (SBRT), also known as Stereotactic ablative radiation therapy (SABR), uses high dose per fraction radiation therapy delivered with extreme precision to the tumour, whilst sparing organs at risk. Treatment is commonly used for bone metastases, nodal metastases, prostate cancers, lung cancers and liver cancers. Treatment is available across our NSW centres.

Deep Inspiration Breath Hold (DIBH) is a technique used for patients with left sided breast cancer undergoing radiation treatment. Deep Inspiration Breath Hold (DIBH) is one way to minimise the radiation dose to the heart. Treatment is available across our NSW treatment centres.

Centre announcement: MR Linac coming to St Vincent's for 2020

State of the art technology will allow our radiation oncologists for the first time to visualise the cancerous tissue during treatment, combining MRI diagnostics with highly targeted radiation therapy. It will allow us to target more complicated cancers such as those in the pancreas with much higher precision. This combined technology significantly minimises the risk of side effects, whilst reducing the overall burden of disease on patients. The machine will enable our radiation oncologists to treat more people with unprecedented accuracy.

Rehabilitation Medicine

The Department provides an assessment and treatment service in all fields of adult rehabilitation medicine. This is offered to both outpatients and inpatients of St Vincent's Private Hospital.

St Vincent's Private Hospital has a 12 bed State of the Art Rehabilitation Unit with a gym, communal therapy areas, a day rehabilitation hospital and a hydrotherapy pool.

Conditions treated include:

- Musculoskeletal rehabilitation for patients with fractures, arthritis, soft tissue injuries, fractured hip, joint replacements and multiple trauma
- Neurological disease such as stroke, multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, neuropathy or myopathy
- Older people's general rehabilitation including decreased mobility, incontinence and falls prevention
- Amputee rehabilitation – pre-operative assessments, pain management assessment and treatment
- Traumatic brain injury and acquired brain injury

Rheumatology

The St Vincent's Clinic Rheumatologists provide diagnosis and management for the full range of adult rheumatic and musculoskeletal diseases (RMDs).

These include inflammatory arthritis (rheumatoid arthritis, psoriatic arthritis, axial spondyloarthritis), gout, osteoarthritis, lupus and anti-phospholipid syndromes, and other connective tissue disorders, as well as pain syndromes, soft tissue rheumatism, spinal disorders and osteoporosis. In fact, over 200 forms of arthritis, musculoskeletal and systemic autoimmune diseases are treated by Rheumatologists.

Close liaison with other departments, state of the art medical imaging services, and collaboration with the

St Vincent's Campus Private Hospital, Public Hospital and Research Precinct help to provide current best-practice level of care.

In addition to the above, Dr Laila Girgis and Dr Ross Penglase have a particular interest and research involvement in connective tissue disease associated interstitial lung disease, scleroderma and myositis overlap syndromes, and vasculitis.

The Department of Sports Medicine provides a comprehensive service for sports people of all levels and disciplines.

They continue to work with local schools and Universities providing a comprehensive sports medicine service.

Surgical Oncology – Breast, Endocrine, Sarcoma & Melanoma Surgery

The department of Surgical Oncology provides specialised care for patients with breast cancer, thyroid cancer, sarcoma, melanoma and a wide range of other tumours.

Surgeons within the department hold appointments at St Vincent's Public and Private Hospitals. All the members of the department have undergone advanced post-fellowship training in Surgical Oncology at prestigious overseas centres.

Consultations for both public and private patients are provided in our offices on level 7 of St Vincent's Clinic.

Surgeons in the department work closely with specialists in Medical Oncology, Radiation Oncology, Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery and Cancer Genetics within the St Vincent's campus to provide truly multidisciplinary care for patients with cancer. Our aim is to provide excellent cancer care, from early diagnosis to ongoing management and follow up. All patients are presented at our regular multidisciplinary tumour group meetings held at the Kinghorn Cancer Centre to ensure that all their care is fully coordinated within the one centre of excellence.

The department of Surgical Oncology provides care for patients with a broad range of tumour groups. These include the following:

- Breast Cancer and benign breast disorders (Drs Chambers, Cheung, Crea, Hargreaves, Nagy, Segara and Wong). The department provides

multidisciplinary care for the diagnosis, treatment and ongoing management of patients with breast cancer and other breast disorders. A full range of breast surgery techniques, including breast conserving surgery, oncoplastic surgery, sentinel lymph node biopsy and breast reconstruction are provided. Genetic testing and the management of high-risk breast cancer patients are also provided.

- Endocrine, Thyroid and Parathyroid Surgery (Drs Chambers and Glover). Surgery for the treatment of thyroid cancer, tumours and other thyroid diseases. Surgery for parathyroid disease and hyperparathyroidism.
 - Adrenal Surgery (Dr Glover). Surgery for adrenal disease.
- Melanoma and advanced cutaneous malignancies (Drs Chambers, Hargreaves and Wong). Surgery including primary tumour resection and reconstruction, sentinel lymph node biopsy and removal of involved lymph nodes.
- Sarcoma and soft tissue tumours (Drs Chambers and Hargreaves). Diagnosis, resection and reconstruction after surgery.
- Neuroendocrine and Gastrointestinal Stromal Tumours (Drs Chambers and Hargreaves)

The Sleep Disorders Service investigates and manages a range of disorders, including excessive daytime sleepiness, snoring, sleep apnoea, respiratory failure in sleep, insomnia, circadian rhythm, and sleep movement disorders.

A comprehensive multidisciplinary service is provided for the management of snoring and sleep apnoea using CPAP, weight management, upper airway surgery and mandibular advancement splints.

The Department of Urology offers a comprehensive, consultative, diagnostic and therapeutic service covering the whole spectrum of urology. An active research program is run in conjunction with the Garvan Institute and the Kinghorn Cancer Centre.

Cancer of the Prostate

The unit has one of the largest experiences in transperineal prostate biopsies, radical prostatectomy and brachytherapy in the country. It was the first unit in New South Wales to perform robot-assisted radical prostatectomy and is the most experienced in New South Wales. External beam radiotherapy with the latest IMRT machine and low and high-dose brachytherapy is offered in conjunction with the Department of Radiation Oncology. Focal therapy with the NanoKnife is a new option for select patients, and the unit is a major teaching centre. The multidisciplinary team has an MDT meeting second weekly to discuss complex cases.

The St Vincent's Prostate Cancer Centre coordinates research into prostate cancer and works closely with the Garvan Institute and the Kinghorn Cancer Centre. It coordinates the clinical aspects of prostate cancer research, chaired by Prof Stricker. It provides research into imaging, MRI, PSMA PET scanning, the procurement of a large tissue bank and database, focal therapy and theranostics. The centre however does not provide clinical prostate cancer services, which are provided by our local urology practitioners (see below).

Cancer of the Bladder

Original research in the department of superficial bladder cancer with expertise with neobladder reconstruction, and more recently robotic cystectomy offers the most up-to-date treatment for all forms of cancer. Blue light diagnostic cystoscopy is also offered.

Cancer of the Kidneys and Testes

The unit has a large experience with complex minimally invasive laparoscopic and robot renal surgery, particularly with robotic partial nephrectomy.

All aspects of renal and testicle surgery and medicine are offered.

Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia

The unit offers all surgical and medical options in the treatment of benign prostatic hyperplasia, including Holmium laser, green light laser, UroLift procedure, transurethral resection of the prostate using bipolar and unipolar techniques and the Rezum procedure.

Incontinence

Full assessment and treatment with outpatient urodynamic assessments, pelvic floor exercises, and bladder training for male and female patients is offered. Surgical treatment including intravesical Botox injection, Sling procedures, ProAct devices, insertion of artificial sphincters are all offered.

Stone Unit

A comprehensive Stone Unit with rigid and flexible ureteroscopy and laser as well as extracorporeal shock wave lithotripsy under anaesthesia with the latest technology are all offered.

Andrology

The unit also has expertise in both the treatment of impotence, sexual rehabilitation and penile prosthetic surgery. In association with the Endocrinology Department, it also manages hypogonadism.

Vascular medicine offers a comprehensive state-of-the-art care for diseases of the circulatory system. This includes veins, arteries, lymphatics and the circulating blood.

The Department's highly trained specialists provide expertise in the treatment and management of:

- Venous diseases including deep vein thrombosis (DVT), pulmonary embolism (PE) and associated clotting disorders; anticoagulation and chronic venous insufficiency, varicose veins and thrombophlebitis
 - Arterial diseases caused by atheroma (cholesterol plaques), arterial thrombosis and embolism; inflammation (vasculitis) and vasospasm disorders (Raynaud's phenomenon and chilblains)
 - Lymphatic diseases including primary and secondary forms of lymphoedema (leg swelling) and other causes of lower limb swelling
 - Assessment and management of cardiovascular risk factors that contribute to arterial and venous disease
- Perioperative and general medical care
 - Vasculitis
 - Lower limb wounds and ulcers

Vascular Surgery

The Department of Vascular Surgery treats patients with the diseases of the arteries, veins, and lymphatics.

These include:

- All aspects of arterial disease, occlusive, non-occlusive and aneurysmal disease are managed with open and endovascular therapy. Common conditions treated include extracranial disease for treatment and prevention of stroke. Aneurysms of thoracic and abdominal aorta with state of the art stenting, fenestrated grafts, hybrid and open surgery
- Conditions treated include traumatic and atherosclerotic dissections. Occlusive disease of aorta, visceral, renal arteries and peripheral arteries are also treated with open and endovascular therapy
- Venous abnormalities treated include varicose veins, venous ulcer, venous thrombosis and compression syndromes. Methods used include radiofrequency ablation, ultrasound guided sclerotherapy, embolisation venous stenting and open surgery

- The department provides vascular access procedures for dialysis and administration of drugs. The surgeons support the St Vincent's Public and Private Hospital renal transplant program and the neurosurgical service with spinal access
- Non-invasive diagnosis and monitoring is available on site by the St Vincent's Clinic Vascular Laboratory

The Department of Vascular Surgery is active in researching and introducing new techniques in treatment of all aspects of Vascular Surgery.


