Enabling improved access to health care services

The unmet need:



"Australians living in **rural and remote areas** tend to have lower life expectancy, higher rates of disease and injury, and **poorer access** to and use of health services, than people living in major cities."



Farmers represent a group at higher risk of a range of health problems. Factors influencing this risk include poorer access to





People living in rural and remote Australia are more likely to face barriers to accessing healthcare. The cost of healthcare (including associated travel and accommodation) is higher with increasing remoteness.
