SUPPORTING THE HEALTH AND WELLBEING OF ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PEOPLE

St Vincent's Clinic Foundation is offering funding of up to \$50,000 for community health services and related research in improving health outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. The aim of the grant is to support healthcare researchers to participate directly in inclusive research projects as a component of their professional career and to impact their community.

Selection criteria

- Evidence of collaborative input from project lead and community.
- Quality of project and how it is expected to impact the community.
- Feasibility to conduct in 12 months noting that extensions may be possible.

Eligibility

- All projects submission must be presented during St Vincent's Clinic Foundation Reconciliation Week Morning Tea on 27 May 2021.
- Consistency with the Foundation's philosophy guided by the ethical framework of Mary Aikenhead Ministries.
